FAQs

The Race

1 What ages/who can participate in the Color Run?

Anyone can participate! The race is designed with Davis and Lane families in mind, so any age is welcome. Participants can walk or run at any speed. We will be staggering the start so that families with younger kids and people opting to walk can start further back in the pack. Out-of-town guests, middle and high schoolers, grandparents, friends from neighboring towns are all welcome too.

2 Is it a race?

It's more of a fun run than a race. We are not timing the event.

3 Where is the race? How long is it?

The race is on the middle school fields, not on any roads. Going around the fields twice will be a 3K distance.

The Powder

1 Is the Color Run powder safe?

Yes, the colored powder is a food grade corn starch. Further detail on the content of the powder is available here: <https://bestptoma.files.wordpress.com/2016/04/chameleon-colors-msds.pdf> Face masks will be available on the day of the race if desired and sunglasses will also be for sale. You are welcome to bring goggles if you would like.

2 What if my child is afraid of things being thrown at them?

The color stations will be staffed by Davis and Lane teachers volunteering for the event. They will be careful not to throw the powder directly into faces.

Logistics

1 What's included in my registration?

Each participant receives a t-shirt and food voucher with their registration. Family registrations receive three t-shirts and three food vouchers. Additional T-shirts can be purchased during the registration process. Additional food vouchers can be purchased at the race.

2 Can I register day of?

Day of registration will be available, but t-shirts are not guaranteed.

3 What should I bring?

It's a good idea to bring a towel or something to sit on in the car on your way home to avoid getting the powder on the seats of your car. Money is also a good idea so you can buy raffle tickets and/ or extra food vouchers.

4 What are the rain plans?

We hope to run the Color Run on Sat. June 4th, even if there is some rain. In the event of a real downpour, the rain date is Sun. Jun. 5th 4pm.

5 Will food be available?

Yes, food will be available. Registrants will each receive one food voucher. Additional food vouchers will be available for purchase.

6 Where should I park?

Only very limited parking will be available at the middle school since our event will be using the parking lot. We suggest parking at the high school/ Mudge Way area and walking to the middle school.
